What is the Canoe Kids Coach Course?

The Canoe Kids Coach Course is an NCCP recognized Canoe/Kayak Canada coach course. Those completing the course and course assignments will be certified as an NCCP Canoe Kids Coach (NCCP Community Coach context). Those taking this course will receive information about teaching introductory canoe/kayak programs and will be certified to teach the Canoe Kids Program.

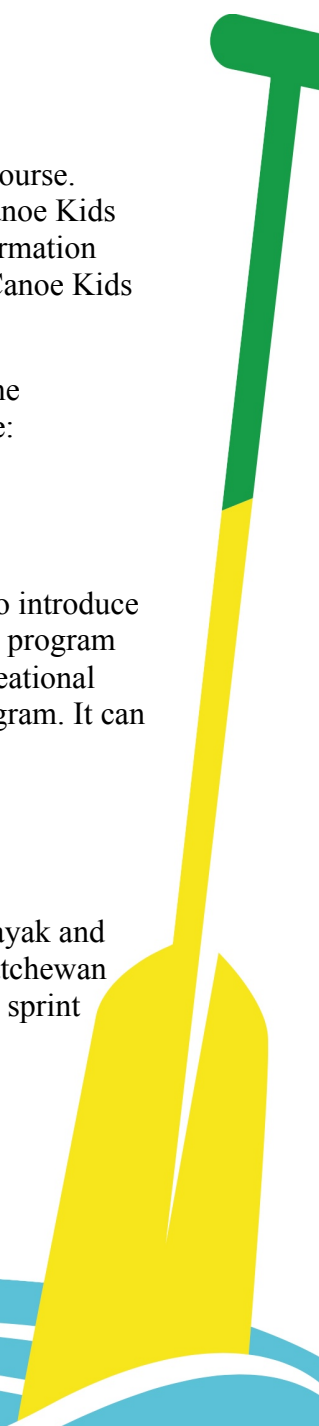

What is the Canoe Kids Program?

- The Canoe Kids Program is a fun, dynamic activity based program designed to introduce participants to basic paddling and safety skills in both canoes and kayaks. The program introduces skills through a progression of 3 levels. Instruction begins at a recreational level and progresses to include an introduction to racing by the end of the program. It can be easily adapted for participants of all ages and abilities.

Who Should Take the Canoe Kids Coach Course?

- Those who want to teach introductory canoeing and kayaking programs.
- Those who want to become a competitive coach in the sport of sprint canoe/kayak and those interested in coaching athletes at multi-sport games including; the Saskatchewan Games, NAIG Games, Canada Games and at provincial, regional and national sprint racing competitions.

- Aspiring instructors or coaches
- People with an interest in White Water Paddling

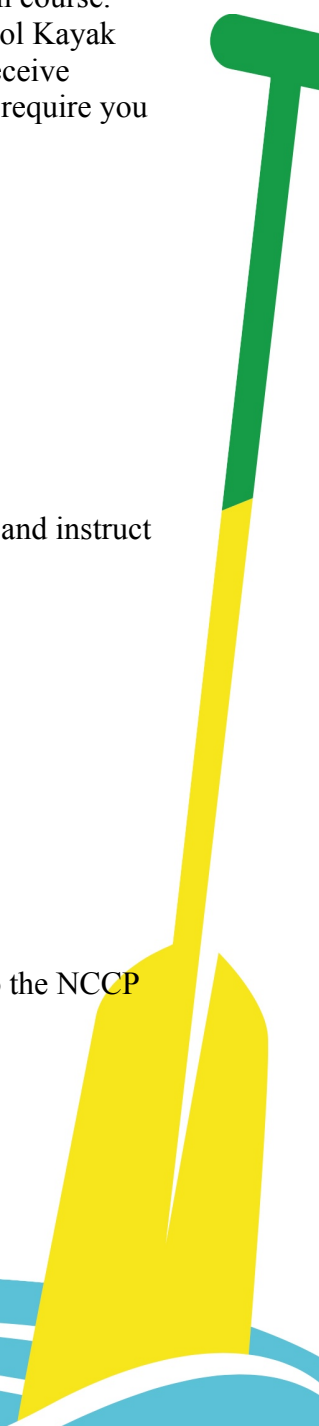
What Would I Learn/ Take Away?
