  - -There are no known conflicting land uses in the surrounding area that would interfere with the intended use of the proposed parcel.
  - -There are no known site conditions that would make the land unsuitable for its intended use.
  - -There are no municipal facilities that would be affected by this proposed development.

Council prefers that the Municipal Reserve requirement be provided as cash-in-lieu, rather than land dedication.

Municipal Reserve (MR) dedication is calculated at 5% of the Assessed Value (194,700) amounting to a cash-in-lieu payment of \$9,735.00.

-The subject land is currently zoned l1 - General Industrial under Zoning Bylaw 939-P-09, as amended by Bylaw 1082-P-19.

295.25 COMMUNITY PLANNING - SUBD - 005051-2025, MULTIPLE LAND LOCATIONS - PROPOSED SASKPOWER RIGHT OF WAY

Halter/Lang: That council approves the subdivision application and advises the following regarding the proposed Sask Power right of way across multiple land locations under Subdivision Application SUBD-005051-2025:

- -Council is not aware of any land uses in the vicinity that would be incompatible with the intended use of the proposed sites.
- -There are no known site conditions that would render the land unsuitable for the proposed Sask Power right of way.
- -The Town of Unity has infrastructure that could be affected by the proposed development. Specifically: a town water line and a lake water line run parallel on the south side of Highway 14. The Town water line services the Northwest Terminal (NWT). The lake line supplies water to compass minerals.
- -No servicing agreement is required for this proposed right of way.
