May 6th - **ALLEY** weekly pick-up begins

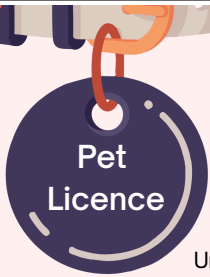
EAST SIDE (every Thursday)

Spring Yard Clean Up

Now is the time to remove Winter's accumulation of items. Furniture, appliances, bags of garbage, dog waste, etc...

Take a look at your trees/shrubs/hedges. Are there branches growing:

- into the driving area of the back alley?
- into the walking area of the sidewalks?
 - close to the power lines?

It is the property owners responsibility to keep these branches trimmed back.

Tree Trimming



The Town of Unity has a Tree Trimming policy.

All boulevard trees are Town property. Any work on these trees **REQUIRES** a permit.

Town trees/ roots that obstruct sidewalks or roads should be brought to the Towns attention.



Dutch Elm cannot be trimmed between April 1st - Sept 1st



Did You Know...

Grass clippings, leaves and any other compostable material can be put in **clear plastic bags** and will be picked up free of charge on your regular garbage pickup day.

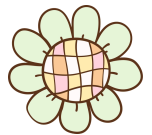

NOT Accepted in Blue Bins: *Styrofoam, *glass, *plastic shopping/grocery bags (EXCLUDING clear bags with shredded paper), *stretchable plastic wrap, household waste, *cardboard beverage containers, clothing, electronics.

*Most of these recyclable materials can be taken to Sarcan.

DO NOT PARK NEAR BLUE BINS

The recycle collection truck requires sufficient space to safely collect bins. If a vehicle is too close, the driver skips the pickup and the bin remains full.

MONTHLY UTILITY BILLING PROCESS

1

COLLECT METER READ

23rd-25th:

Remote Meter reading captures current month water usage.



2

VERIFICATION

Review and validate readings. Calculate charges for water/sewer/other fees.



3

NOTICE GENERATED

Utility Bill sent to resident on 30th of each month via mail or Customer Portal.



4

ACCOUNT MGMT

1st-25th

Process payments, ownership changes, & auto-pay (20th). Post payment reminders on social media & customer portal.



5

REMINDER NOTICE

Door Tag notices are issued 3-5 days after the due date for prior month(s) unpaid utility bills. (30+ days after date of issue).



DID YOU KNOW?



Payments received by the **25th** are reflected on your notice.

Payments received after the **25th** will have a balance carried forward on the next utility notice.
